



Year 1 - Maths Learning Week beginning 18th May 2020



Please have a go at completing one of these activities per day. We would normally teach one Maths lesson per day in school; so this will therefore be equivalent to what your child would normally be doing. Thank you!

Time

Write down a list of times you do things during the day. For example, time you get up; have breakfast/lunch/tea; time you go for a walk. How long do you do each activity for? Can you put these times in order and create a timeline?

Number bonds

Continue to practise your number bonds to 20. Learn them off by heart too! You could also write these down on some paper. Ask an adult to time you to see how fast you can say them/write them!



Maths Number Problems

Write some Maths problems solving questions of your own involving fairy tales and solve them. Try to challenge your child with numbers up to 20 or beyond. For example, 'There are 10 little pigs. If the Big Bad Wolf scares 3 of them away, how many are left?'. 'The number of Bears that Goldilocks met added to the number of Dwarves that Snow White - $3+7 = 10$.'

Have a go at writing at least 5!



Capacity

Use an egg cup to measure water into other containers. Create a table of your results. You may also like to..... make coloured or glittery potions to fill bottles or spend time talking about litres and millilitres.
