Statistics - Tally Charts

Think of a category for a tally chart (e.g. favourite food, favourite animal, favourite colour). Can you contact members of your family and friends and find out their favourite? Create a tally chart and see which is the most popular/least popular. Challenge yourself by making a graph of this data too!

Number Ordering

Use some paper to make some number cards (up to 20; or beyond if you're feeling up to a challenge!). Can you cut them out and order them on some paper? Discuss place value and how you know which number is the smallest or the greatest.



Position and Direction

Have a look around your house at where abouts various items are. Use language such as: in front of, behind, above, below, left, right, next to, underneath. Can you place various items in different places and give a family member some clues using positional language to help them find each item? Take some photos or draw a picture of where you place the items.



Measurement - Length

Find yourself some paper, pencil and a ruler. Have a look at the ruler and discuss centimetres with an adult. Can you draw a line using your ruler? Listen carefully to an adult when they tell you a length (e.g. 8cm). As a challenge - can you draw a length that includes half measurements? E.g. 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ cm.
