Log onto BBC Bitesize and complete each Y6 Daily English and Maths activity as they are updated. (Don't print or photocopy anything; simply watch the videos, read the information and click on the tasks. You can record down any notes on some paper you have at home, if necessary).

There are Maths and English sessions every day followed by some element of topic work.

Alternatively, if you are struggling to access electronic devices within your home, you can use 'The Red Button' Bitesize daily across the BBC - Primary or BBC iPlayer. The Lancashire Maths team who support Lancashire schools with Maths have provided further Maths activities.

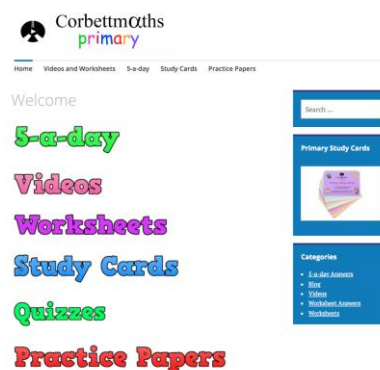
