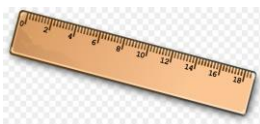
Time

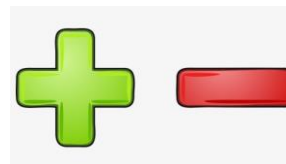
Measurement

Can you have a go at measuring how tall you or someone else in your house is? Can you measure your height with hand spans, or Lego blocks, or even a tape measure (if you have one)? Create a little table to record your results.



Addition and Subtraction

In school, we would normally continue to recap addition and subtraction in order to build the children's confidence, fluency and speed.
Please have a go at some more simple addition and subtraction questions, keeping the numbers around 20. Can you come up with your own questions? Remember to check that your numbers are the correct way around



Fractions

Have a go at recapping fractions. Can you do some work on fractions of a pizza or a circle/square that you draw? There are two fractions sheets with this pack, for you to have a go at.
