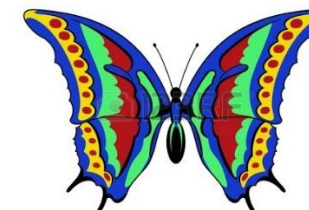
Outdoor Maths

Can you create a symmetrical picture? You could use shapes or draw your favourite things. Remember, both sides should be exactly the same. You could start with the butterfly pictures attached.



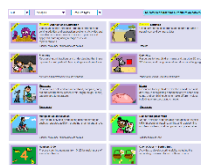
Espresso - Maths
