Many of us are also reading avidly at home and our progress in reading is a joy to see!









We Are Writers!

What makes us most proud about our writing in EYFS is that at any time, indoors or out, we can be found happily initiating our own writing-so lovely to see!






We work hard every week "to be the best mathematicians we are able to be". In-depth exploration of each number to ten during the Autumn term has given us a real understanding and we are confident in problem solving, counting and early calculating. Maths is fun and we have developed the confidence to rise to challenges from this very early stage.



Our daily focused sessions in Maths are enhanced by problem solving activities in our play. We are currently enjoying exploring addition and subtraction using the "part/part/whole" method, which we love to demonstrate!
