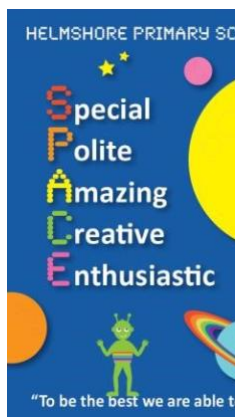

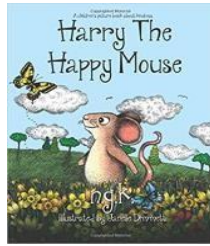

We will endeavour to provide lots of opportunities throughout the curriculum for every child to shine in the focus areas.

SPACE

Autumn Term 1- Our theme for the autumn term is **Splendid Seasons**



During this theme, we take time to settle into our new classroom environment, whilst providing the children with as many exciting opportunities as possible. We aim to work outdoors when we can, making use of a variety of resources.

Our curriculum focusses will be:

English - 'Harry the Happy Mouse' novels written by N.G.K; we will learn the key features of a narrative and retell our own stories. We will recite and retell weather poems and we will write our own weather poems with links to seasons of the year.

Maths - Place Value -Simple addition/subtraction; writing numerals up to 20; ordering numbers up to 20.

Key focus on number bonds to 10 and 20 with mental recall of these.

Length mass and Weight - Practical measuring, longest/shortest; practical activities; heaviest/lightest.

Addition - Practical activities; simple addition using cubes/number lines.

Subtraction - Practical activities; simple subtraction; using cubes/number lines.

2D and 3D shapes - Practical exploration; recognise /record properties.

Science - Seasonal changes - We will learn about the four seasons, seasonal weather. We will name the seasons and know about the type of weather in each season.

Geography - Weather - We will learn about the weather of the day. We will learn why the weather is so important for people. We will research where in the world we will find extreme weather. We will learn different weather symbols and add symbols to a map.

Art - painting and rubbing - We will learn the names of primary and secondary colours. We will make leaf rubbings and patterns and learn about the famous artist - William Morris.

R.E. - Christianity - Why do Christians say that God is a father? We will learn the importance of prayer or Christians.

PSHE- 'Being me and my world'; focusing on how to help others feel welcome, think about everyone's right to learn; devising and following our class charter (rules and expectations).

Computing icompute - (iAlgorithm) introducing instructions; commands and devising their own algorithm for their friends to follow.

P.E- Our focuses are Gymnastics and Fundamental movement skills. In Dance, we will look at different ways of travelling and jumping - using the Three Little Pigs Story. We will be conveying contrasting (pigs and wolf) characters linking different movement and travelling ideas. We then move onto creating short sequences of these movements. For our Fundamental movement skills we focus on assessing children's hopping, jumping, underarm and overarm throwing, running fast, skipping, catching, bouncing, rolling and kicking a ball.

Lots of our curriculum can be covered in our themes. However, we continue to teach certain subjects in discrete lessons, whilst making topic connections when this is appropriate.
