This is what is offered to us by Rossendale School Sports Partnership.

Membership **£2,500**

Breakdown-

**Full time support of School Games Organiser (SGO)** to provide strategic coordination and development of the; RSSP Programme, partnership activities and line management function to RSSP staff. Which includes -Access to additional programmes- Change4life, Primary Sports Leadership, School Sport Crew's and Gifted and Talented programme, through resources and training. Termly Primary PE coordinator meetings, managing funding as well as monitoring and evaluating use of bikeability funding for all Rossendale schools-wider networking and additional training opportunities. Partnership working with Rossendale Leisure Trust, NGB's, County Sport Partnership, local boroughs, sport clubs and local organisations. Support on working towards School Games Mark. Further support and advice on remaining sports premium, brokerage with external providers to get 'best value' for partnership schools = **£600**

**Inclusion Officer-** working for the partnership one day a week, connecting schools with inclusive and disability specific programmes and resources as well as offering to work with small groups of pupils on their physical literacy and run two inclusion events each half term. **£250**

**Competitions, Festivals and Events-** over 40 events throughout the year, each event offering clear intent and outcomes catering for all young people's needs. The events increase participation in competitive school sport, helping pupils to deal with adversity and success, develop perseverance and resilience and develop sport specific skills and individual development in sport. Celebration events aid schools in the engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity – kick-starting healthy active lifestyles, provide opportunities for less active pupils to represent their school, help foster Social Connections and engage new audiences. **£400**

**CPD-** package through Lancashire County Council and YST (curriculum development) and National Governing Bodies (sport specific) schools to receive a minimum of 4 in person CPD days as well as over 10 online webinar opportunities. Providing staff with training development and support, either through Zoom or in person. To increase confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport. To support the profile of PE and sport across the school as a tool for whole school improvement. **£250**

**Youth Sport Trust (YST) Membership-** All schools to become members of the YST and gain access to a plethora of online resources and the most up to date national advice around PE and School Sport. **£50**

**Mental Health Champions Training-** A student-led intervention, designed to make use of physical activity as a proactive solution to mental health and wellbeing issues present within schools. Schools attending a seminar will identify an allocated number of pupils, 'Young Mental Health Champions' to attend a full day of training. Seminars use a YST Athlete Mentor to work directly with the young people to provide training, support and resources for them to become Young Mental Health Champions. The seminar will also provide support for the lead member of staff supporting the Young Mental Health Champions and look at how the approach can be embedded back in school. There will be two follow up support and reflection sessions for your Young Mental Health Champions. **£150**

**PE Specialist Support-** Curriculum Support in PE- working with members of staff across the school to help with the planning and teaching of PE. This can range from helping with curriculum mapping for the year across the school, helping with the general planning of PE, team teaching with staff who lead or support in PE lessons and supporting with any other needs schools may have regarding PE.

Support with the PE Passport App- offering help and guidance to schools who have access to the PE Passport app for the Lancashire Scheme of Work. This includes offering support on how it can be used with the planning and assessment of PE lessons as well as how it can be used effectively for extra-curricular activities. Any other general support with PE and school sport. **£200**

**Credit System-** schools to receive further support through a credit system. Working with local and national providers to offer a more bespoke package to meet the needs of each individual school, the SSP has negotiated with providers to get 'best value' for partnership schools (please see your SLA for full list of providers which you will be able to pick and choose using up your 'credits'. **£600**
