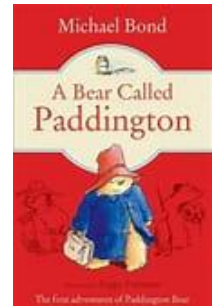

English

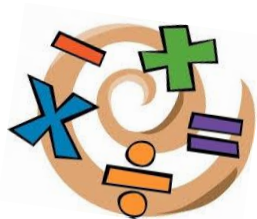


Maths

During this half term we look at:

Computing - iCompute - Unit: iNetwork

In this unit children will learn about networks. They will learn about computer networks including the internet the World Wide Web and the opportunities they offer for communication.



Science (Continued from last term)

We look at nutrition, diet and the skeleton whereby the children:

Identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat.

Identify that an adequate and varied diet is beneficial to health (along with a good supply of air and clean water).

Identify that regular and varied exercise from a variety of different activities is beneficial to health.

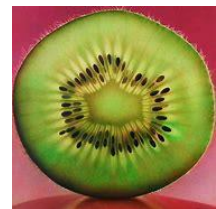


Design and Technology

The children will design and create a large structure that represents their local area.

Art

PE/Games

The children have a PE session and a games session each week. Invasion Games (Rugby) and Yoga.



RE - Islam

Why is the Prophet Muhammad an example for Muslims? During our lessons pupils will explore and examine the origins of Islam. The focus is on founders and leaders, using stories and teachings to identify how the values contained within them can inspire and influence a believer today.



PSHE - Celebrating Difference

The children will look at celebrating differences with families and learn how to deal with conflicts that may arise with family and friends. We will also learn about bullying and how we should only use kind words.
