Be a role model:

Remember, whenever you're wearing your school uniform, you are representing school, even if you are outside school. Children need to behave as sensibly as they can at all times.

In class:

- *Be a team player and try to contribute
- *Listen carefully to adults and to each other
- *Keep focused and motivated
- *Sit nicely on your chair
- *Look after resources and equipment
- *Be organised
- *Work quietly and sensibly
- *Try to be independent and seek help when you really need it
- *Always give your best



Playtimes:

Often, a simple game can become too boisterous, ending in someone playing too roughly and others getting hurt. Sometimes, it is because children don't stop and think about the impact before they do something that seems like fun.

Children need to:

- *Choose a sensible game to play that doesn't involve any kind of hurting
- *Always be mindful of others
- *Try to remind each other to play nicely and include everyone
- *Remember to play safely
- *Stop and think before a game becomes too rough
- *Seek help if a game is becoming too rough
- *Tell staff about any issues
- *Treat others how you would like to be treated
- *Stop, be quiet and listen when the bell rings so that everyone can get back into school quickly and safely

We are very respectful and inclusive at our school of all children- we need to make sure we are kind to everyone at playtimes too.

At lunchtimes:

- *Use calm, sensible voices
- *Only speak when you have swallowed your food
- *Pick up any dropped food
- *Sit nicely and use your cutlery carefully
- *Take your time and don't rush



Around school:

- *Walk sensibly, keeping to the left
- *Hold doors open for others
- *Walk round the edge of the hall
- *Be helpful by picking up any dropped items
