

SPRING TERM

Spring Term 2 - Plant Life



English

In English, we are looking at stories with a familiar setting, 'Mudpuddle Farm', where the children will plan and write their own story. We will also look at persuasion and creating an informative leaflet trying to persuade someone to visit the farm.



Maths

During this year in Maths, we are following the Lancashire Maths Planning Support Materials, where we cover length, addition and subtraction, 2D and 3D shape, fractions, position and direction and time.



Science

During this half term, we look at plants and trees how they grow. We will look at a variety of different trees and the different parts of a tree and how they take in water and carbon dioxide and give out oxygen.



Geography

In Geography we will look at the main differences between a place in England and a non-European country. We will complete a comparative study between Kenya and England.



Design and Technology

We look at creating our own moving monster, we explore pivots, levers and linkages and we will design and make our own moving monster.



Music

In music, we are learning how to play the recorder and read music, by the end of the term the children will be able give a performance to celebrate their success.



Computing

In Computing we use iCompute and this half term we use iProgram where we will understand what algorithms are, how they are implemented as programs on digital devices. We will also create and debug simple programs.



PE



In PE this half term, we look at Gymnastics the children will create a sequence using travel and balances. We will also look at throwing and catching with improved accuracy, and we will work on simple tactics within a game.

RE

In RE we look at Islam and the key question: Why do Muslims believe it is important to obey God? During this topic, we will look at submission, gratitude and prayer.



PSHE



This half term we look at 'Healthy Me' where we make healthy choices and explain why they are good for our body.

During this half term the children will also participate in World Book Day.
