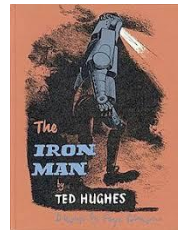

Spring Term 2nd Half - Theme - The Iron Man

As winter comes to a close and Spring is in the air, we move onto our next topic starring 'The Iron Man'.

English

We study 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes as our novel with a theme, then the children have to write their own version based on Chapter 1 of the text. This is then followed by studying the Iron Man poem By Brenda Williams - whereby the children have to write their own diary entry as the final outcome.



Maths

Computing - iCompute - Unit: iData

This unit explores how information is organised in a database.



Science - Forces and Magnets

In this unit the children will:

- Compare how some things move on different surfaces.
- Notice that some forces need contact between two objects but magnetic forces can act at a distance.
- Observe how magnets attract or repel each other and attract some materials and not others.
- Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of whether they are attracted to a magnet and identify some magnetic materials.
- Describe magnets as having two poles.
- Predict whether two magnets will attract or repel each other, depending on which poles are facing each other.



Art

Pupils will use the environment as a starting point for creating patterns, recording rubbing and printing. The children will also study the work of artist William Morris.



PE/Games - Dance (Ironman) and Invasion Games (Handball).

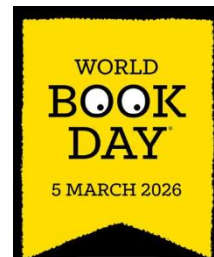
RE - What do Christians mean by the Holy Spirit?
