



Welcome to Year 1



Welcome to our exciting learning journey for **Summer 1** - we hope you enjoy it!

Throughout the academic year, we follow the National Curriculum closely to ensure the children receive a broad and balanced learning journey that enhances their enthusiasm to be the best that they are able to be.

Summer 1 Term - Our theme for the summer 1 term is 'Happy Helmshore'.



Our curriculum focusses will be:

English - We will read a story based on a familiar setting such as Percy the Park Keeper by Nick Butterworth. We will use familiar plots for structuring the opening, middle and end of our stories.

Maths - place value - Read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words. Count, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals. Given a number, identify one more and one less. Given a number, identify ten more and ten less. Addition and subtraction - Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20. Add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20, including zero. Capacity - Compare, describe and solve practical problems capacity/volume (full/empty, more than, less than, quarter). Fractions - Recognise, find and name a half as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity. Position - Describe position, directions and movements, including half, quarter and three-quarter turns.

Science - Plants - common plants, plant structure. We will identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees. We will know and name a variety of wild and garden plants. We will know and name the petal, stem, leaves and roots of a plant. We will know and name the trunk, branches and leaves of a tree.

Geography - Our Local Area - In this theme children will learn simple fieldwork skills, including observation and recording, we will study the geography of our school and its grounds. We will investigate the key human and physical features of its surrounding environment. We will focus on how to make our school grounds better for plants and animals with a focus on sustainability.

Art - 3d art collage - We will create a 3d picture using coiling and twisting, we will use textures and materials to create artwork. We will know how to cut, roll and coil materials. We will create a picture with IT.

R.E. - Hindu Dharma - What do Hindus believe about God? One God in many forms, God is all things, expressing ideas about God.

PSHE- Relationships - We will identify members of our family and know that there are different types of families. We will learn who can help us in our school community.

Music - By the sea - We will use our bodies to make music. We will create movements that match the music, explaining why they are moving in that way. We will identify descriptive sounds within the music. We will recreate and then adapt descriptive sounds heard using their voice or body.

Computing - iwrite - This unit introduces basic word processing. The children learn how to enter and print text, save and retrieve work. iSafe - eSafety teaching is embedded and flagged throughout all lessons.

P.E- Athletics - children will travel accurately in different ways. **Fundamental skills** - overarm throw - children will demonstrate an overarm throw with some accuracy and apply to tactical games.
