Welcome to our exciting learning journey for **Summer 2** - we hope you enjoy it!

Throughout the academic year, we follow the National Curriculum closely to ensure the children receive a broad and balanced learning journey that enhances their enthusiasm to be the best that they are able to be.

Summer 2 Term - Our theme for the summer 2 term is 'Marvellous Materials'.



Our curriculum focusses will be:

English - We will write stories with fantasy setting 'How to train a train.' We will read and write a recount and learn poems by heart.

Maths - We will solve one-step problems that involve addition and subtraction using concrete objects and pictorial representations, and missing number problems such as $7 = \Delta - 9$. Recognise find and name a half as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity. Recognise and name common 2-D shapes, including squares, circles, rectangles and triangles. Describe position, directions and movements including half, quarter and three-quarter turns.

Science - Materials - We will know the name of the materials an object is made from. We will learn about the properties of everyday materials.

History - William Turner - We will learn about the history of our local area. We will learn about the significance of William Turner. We will visit Helmshore Textile Museum and learn about life in the past compared to our own lives.

DT - Food - Healthy sandwiches - We will learn how bread is made. We will research and taste different breads, design a healthy sandwich as part of a balanced diet, cut food safely, choose healthy ingredients, use tools safely, evaluate our healthy sandwiches and suggest ways to improve our sandwiches.

R.E. - Christianity (church) - How might some people show that they 'belong' to God? Baptism and belonging.

PSHE- Changing me - To start to understand the life cycles of animals and humans. To understand that changes happen as we grow and that this is OK. To know how my body has changed since I was a baby. To understand that growing up is natural and that everybody grows at different rates. To respect my body and understand which parts are private.

Music - Children are introduced to the concept of timbre; learning that different sounds can represent characters and key moments in a story. They explore clapping along to the syllables of words and phrases before creating rhythmic patterns to tell a familiar fairy tale.

Computing - iData - Here, the children learn how to collect, organise and represent data using digital graphing tools.

ESafety - isafe - We will learn how to keep safe online. We will learn the meaning of staying safe online; the importance of keeping personal information and passwords safe; the potential dangers of meeting people online; how to find safe and reliable content; who to go to for help; and how to enjoy safely the many opportunities the internet has to offer.

P.E- Gymnastics - We will balance, roll, jump and travel in different ways. We will then apply our skills to apparatus. We will learn to have self-belief and learn new things and improve if I try.
